Creating Green Graduates: Engaging students with sustainability in every step of their journey

Why should I attend?

Student engagement is one of the priority areas for sustainability teams in higher and further education at present.

The University of Leicester's student engagement scheme has grown exponentially over the past 7 years. Each year, our volunteers contribute the equivalent of 1.5 FTE staff members , staff co-supervise a number of student projects and up to 30 students a year gain a Leicester Award for Sustainability (there is also a volunteering award). Many of our volunteers and interns have gone on to secure positions in the sustainability sector and beyond in many disciplines and countries.

Our Students' Union is Green Impact 'Excellence'; we have Environment Officers in the Student Council. We have also successfully won a Green Fund bid resulting in running to keep up with students as opposed to persuading and cajoling them!

Delegates will hopefully be inspired by the lessons we have learned and be able to identify new opportunities for their own student engagement opportunities. We will support them to identify ways to make those opportunities happen. Delegates will be encouraged to use the Positive Behaviours COP to support
