Considerations & plan of action!

- Limited budget
- Student involvement?
- Marketing & Comms plenty of warning!
- Meeting with videographer
- Write video outline, using GGA application
- Film!
- Edit, approve & send off



Top tips!

- Identify your budget
- Use your contacts within the university, including M&C and students!
- If you have limited time, don't make the video yourself – get someone else to do it!
- Meet with the person producing the video, before you start shooting. You can discuss the style, timelines and expectations.
- Use a template to outline the video content, locations/ backdrops and if you can use any existing material, & use your application for content. (identify key points)



Top tips continued

- Don't be afraid to write want you want people to say, and talk it through to estimate on timings.
- Share the template and copy with those being filmed and get them to read it before the filming process begins – they will be more comfortable & you'll save time.
- Listen to the pros and be flexible with locations/ settings.
- Provide whoever is making the video with the things they need e.g. Green Gown images & the info sheet
