What is this survey?

This is the mandatory reporting survey all SDG Accord institutional signatories must complete annually on how their institution contributes to the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). By signing the SDG Accord - you have recognised the central and transformational role educators have in attaining the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) by 2030 through improved collaboration and aligning of efforts. You are part of the change - and we thank-you.

Do I have to do this?

Yes – as an SDG Accord institutional signatory - you have committed to this. It is up to you who within your institution is best placed to fill this in on behalf of your institution.

What will you do with the information?

The EAUC will collate it and turn it into a report that gives an overview of the post-16 education sector and how it is contributing to the SDGs globally. Examples of best practice will be championed in the report with permission from the signatory. This report will be presented to the UN High Political Forum in July. It will also be made available as a resource publically.

Important information:

This survey will take no more than 15 minutes.

Acknowledging many institutions are at different stages of their SDG journey,

you should not find it prescriptive or difficult.

The individual responses provided will be confidential and the report will be a

collation of all the results as a whole.

Only one person from each institution should fill this survey in and the person filling it in should have the authority to report on behalf of their institution.
